

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Service Hour Requirements

In an effort to demonstrate our Christian commitment to service, each year the middle school students are required to fulfill a determined amount of service hours. The completion of these service hours is recorded as a “bump up” or “bump down” in their grade at the *end of the year*. For example, if a student has earned a “B” at the end of the school year, it will be elevated to a “B+” if the service hours are completed, or lowered to a “B-” if not completed.

The requirements for sixth grade are as follows:

During one school class period, sixth grade students, under the direction of the religion teacher, will prepare sandwiches for an area meal program. This past year’s recipient was the Guest House of Milwaukee.

Each sixth grade student shall volunteer for a **minimum 2-hour shift at either the Fish Fry or the Pancake Breakfast** for set-up, serving and/or clean-up. \*In addition to the Fish Fry, Pancake Breakfast and sandwich making, students shall complete **2 hours of parish/ school/ community service**.
